

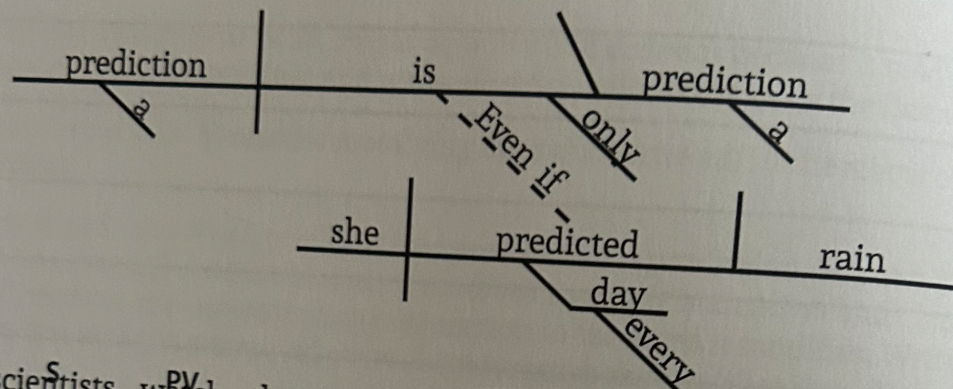

1. Analyze the following sentences, and then diagram them in the space provided. Use a pencil to draw the lines.

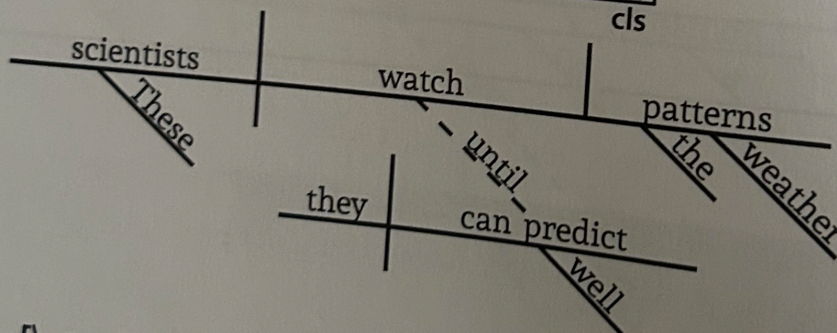
a. [Even if she predicted rain (every day,)] a prediction is only a prediction.

Labels: *adj*, *S*, *pv*, *adj*, *adj*, *do*, *adv cls*, *s*, *hv*, *pv*, *adv*.



c. Sometimes, [when they predict sunshine,] heavy rains come instead.

Labels: *adv*, *adv cls*, *s*, *pv*, *do*, *adj*, *S*, *adj*, *PV*, *come*, *adv*.
