one ^{lv} seemed ^{PA} attentive (to the choir director) tonight.

Diagram: Arrows from 'one' to 'seemed' (lv), 'seemed' to 'attentive' (PA), 'attentive' to 'to' (p), 'to' to 'the' (adv), 'the' to 'choir' (prep), 'choir' to 'director' (adv), 'director' to 'tonight' (adv), 'tonight' to 'seemed' (adv).

Some ^S came ^{PV} early [while] others came late (to the practice.)]

Diagram: Arrows from 'Some' to 'came' (S), 'came' to 'early' (PV), 'early' to 'while' (adv), 'while' to 'others' (adv), 'others' to 'came' (S), 'came' to 'late' (PV), 'late' to 'to' (p), 'to' to 'the' (adv), 'the' to 'practice' (adv), 'practice' to 'came' (adv).

3. Willis, ^{hv} is ^S everyone (from your family) ^{PV} coming tomorrow?

Diagram: Arrows from 'Willis' to 'is' (hv), 'is' to 'everyone' (S), 'everyone' to 'from' (p), 'from' to 'your' (adv), 'your' to 'family' (adv), 'family' to 'coming' (PV), 'coming' to 'tomorrow' (adv), 'tomorrow' to 'coming' (adv).

S (You) ^{PV} Stop the chatter and listen (to one another.)

Diagram: Arrows from '(You)' to 'Stop' (S), 'Stop' to 'chatter' (PV), 'chatter' to 'and' (adv), 'and' to 'listen' (PV), 'listen' to 'to' (p), 'to' to 'one' (adv), 'one' to 'another' (adv), 'another' to 'listen' (adv).

5. ^{hv} Is ^S anybody ^{PV} bringing his binder (on stage?)

Diagram: Arrows from 'Is' to 'anybody' (hv), 'anybody' to 'bringing' (S), 'bringing' to 'binder' (PV), 'binder' to 'his' (adv), 'his' to 'on' (p), 'on' to 'stage' (adv), 'stage' to 'bringing' (adv).

Labels: S, lv, PA, adv, adv, prep, p, adj, adj, op
